With its gentle handling techniques and guided physical exercises Tellington TTouch is a great way of working with your dog. TTouch can help dogs become more relaxed, focused and alert. This approach can help with a variety of problems including pulling on the lead, fear of loud noises, reactivity to other dogs and so on. It also has benefits for dogs who compete as it can help to increase confidence, concentration and co-ordination during training and competition. For all dogs, throughout their stages of development from puppies to seniors, TTouch can help improve the dog's general well-being



On the introductory day you will learn the principles behind the work, some basic ttouches, handling techniques, and how to use the wraps. You will be able to experience for yourself how the TTouch method can be of benefit to your dog.

The workshop is informal and the activities are fun - you will have the opportunity to practise ttouches with each other and with your dogs during the day. So you'll be able to go away with some more practical skills that you can then continue with at home.

We work with the dogs in a very calm, focused way and I find all the dogs (and their owners) are very relaxed by the end of the day.
